Re: RPA Fertility Unit – Low-Cost IVF Services

I am pleased to announce that the Royal Prince Alfred (RPA) Fertility Unit is participating in the NSW Health Affordable IVF Initiative, providing low-cost IVF services to people who need it across NSW.

After a busy catch-up period following on from the COVID-19 pandemic, capital works and the procurement of additional equipment, the RPA Fertility Unit is now running at an increased capacity. Initial consultations can be undertaken without delay, with treatment for suitable patients expected within a few weeks of their first clinic visit.

The RPA Fertility Unit has also partnered with Genea Elements, to provide affordable IVF services to patients at their Bella Vista clinic in accordance with the NSW IVF Initiative. This will extend the provision of low-cost IVF treatment to patients within the Hills District region.
