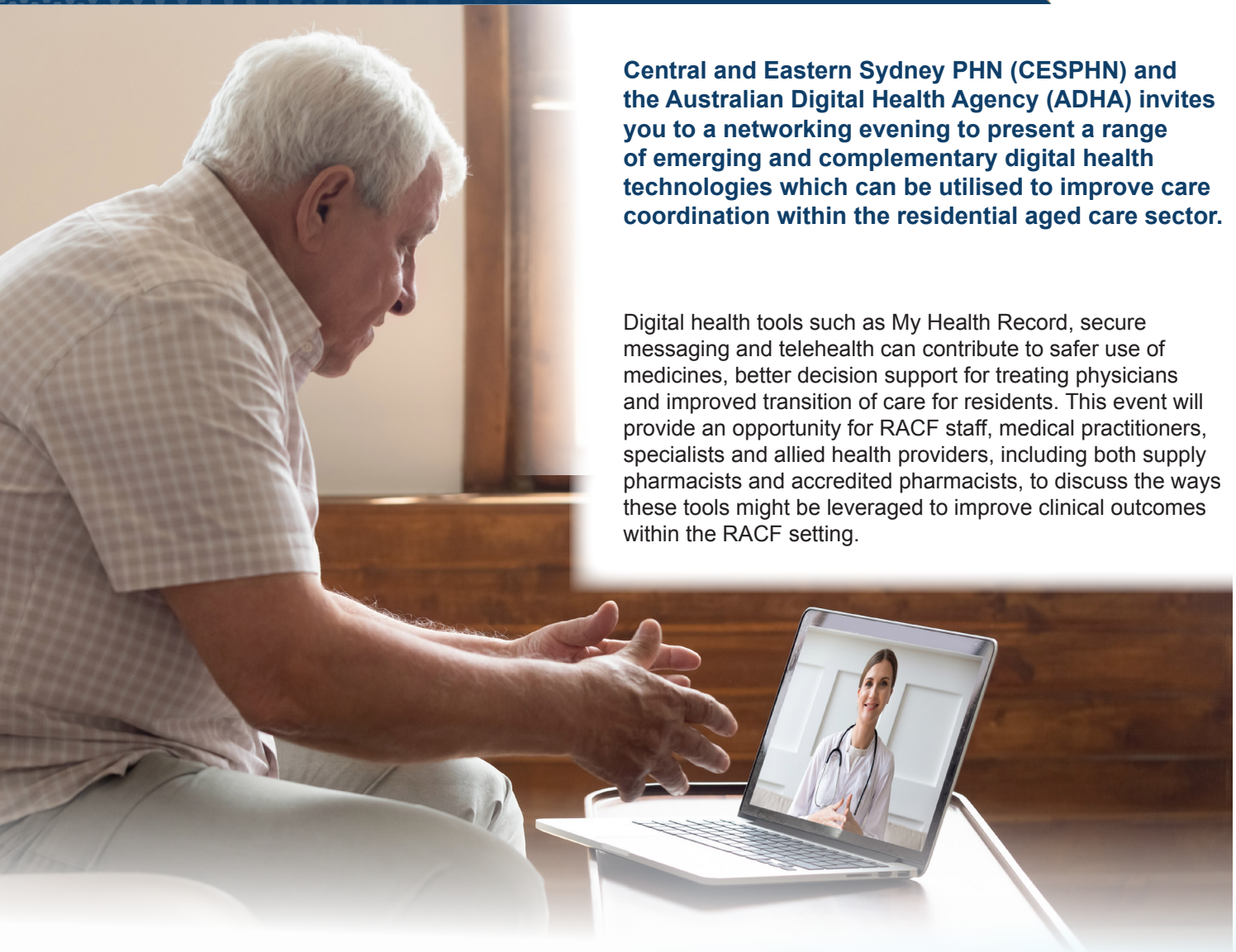


IMPROVING CARE COORDINATION IN AGED CARE
