## GP representative for South Eastern Sydney Local Health District End of Life Committee

### Background

The South Eastern Sydney Local Health District End of Life Care Committee (EOLC) is a collaboration between South Eastern Sydney Local Health District, The Sydney Children's Hospitals Network and Illawarra Shoalhaven Local Health District which provides governance over the development and implementation of district wide policies and procedures for end of life care. The EOLC will advise the South Eastern Sydney Local Health District Clinical and Quality Council on strategic direction for quality end of life care delivered in partnership with relevant NSW Health, government agencies and inter-sectoral partners.

The EOLC is seeking a GP representative practising in the South Eastern Sydney Local Health District region to join the committee.

### Overview of GP representative role

#### *Responsibilities will include:*

- Ensure that EOLC action is aligned with organisational service improvement strategies
- In collaboration with acute, primary, aged care and specialist palliative care sectors advise on the development of EOLC deliverables, plans and a system that supports personalised, safe, efficient, effective, and enhanced provision of care to patients
- Assist with resolving strategic issues and risks
- Monitor and evaluate the EOLC as it is delivered and achievements realised against facility EOLC plans
- Provide advice and guidance on business issues and constraints facing the EOLC
- Set directions for and monitor an EOLC program of work
- Recognise, foresee and develop mitigation strategies for any potential clinical risks

#### *Selection criteria*

- Interest to influence best practice in advance care planning.
- GP must be practising in the South Eastern Sydney Local Health District region.

#### *Time commitment*

The Committee meets bi-monthly. The length of the meeting is yet to be determined.

#### *Remuneration*

CESPHN Representatives are appointed as per the terms and conditions outlined in the EIS Health Ltd Representation Policy (attached). GP Representatives are reimbursed for their time at the current CESPHN approved GP representative rate. CESPHN also reimburses any pre-approved, reasonable out of pocket expenses which are incurred in connection with the performance of their role.
